Welcome & Quorum

Audit/Review Discussion

Granger Smith presented the Board with Manley Garvin, LLC's Scopes of Work, as well as Prices, for their Review and Audit Processes. Josh Garvin answered questions via phone call. Architectural Control Committee Update

Entrance/Enclave Tree Project Update

Granger Smith updated the Board that R&G Tree Services had completed the removal of all items listed on the Tree Removal RFP, and that stumps had been grinded as well. However, the Board recommended holding a portion of his total invoice back until he had made the agreed-upon repairs to 102 Sand Trap Lane's Driveway.

Phase 2 – Gary Odom suggested forming a committee to determine what each remaining entrance needs to have planted, and then reach out to Old Pros Landscaping to evaluate.

Speed Control Signs

Granger Smith informed the Board that he was still waiting to hear back from Matthew Mills with Greenwood County Roads Department on obtaining information for more Speed Limit Signs to be placed along the main thoroughfare through Hunters Creek Boulevard. Bruce Culbertson emailed the Board a Speed Limit Detection Reader that is popular within other Associations. He suggested purchasing a few of them to spread throughout the community. Granger is going to reach out to Greenwood County regarding the POA installing a few, flashing Rate-of-Speed Signs.

2022 Lawn Care

The Board reviewed the received bids. After careful consideration of all bids, the Board took a vote to accept Old Pros Lawn Care's submission. All were in favor of proceeding with Old Pros Lawn Care. Communication will be had with the winning bidder to begin soon.
